## Melrose Center Announces 2022 Melrose Film Festival Selections



The Dorothy Lumley Melrose Center at the Orlando Public Library announces the selected films for [2022 Melrose Film Festival](#). The films are available to be screened online beginning Friday, September 9 at noon and will remain accessible through Saturday, September 24 at 6 p.m. A selection of 76 films representing more than 20 countries were chosen from over 2,000 submissions. The selection includes nine short films in Spanish with subtitles.

This is the Melrose Film Festival's fifth year, and it is entirely virtual. Categories include Animated Shorts, Documentaries, Micro Shorts, Music Videos and Short Films. Melrose Center staff will also offer virtual and in-person events on scene and character development, screenwriting, sound effects, 3D animation, and motion capture on select dates throughout the festival.

Driven by innovation and creativity, the Melrose Film Festival celebrates the art of visual storytelling and highlights the work of imaginative filmmakers across the globe.
