Looking to upskill for your current or future career? LinkedIn Learning offers online, on-demand classes and

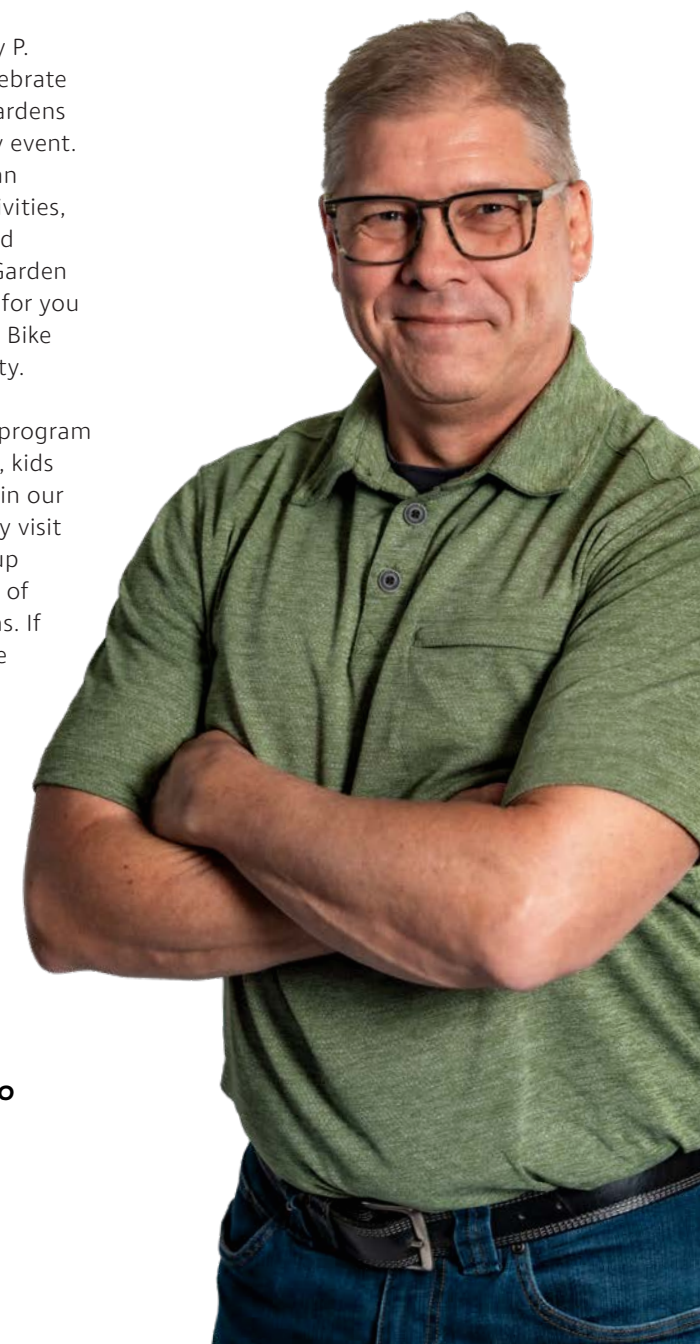
